

# BEULAH BEACH CAMPGROUND RULES

- 1. Registration:** Campers must register at the lodge during office hours. Reservations are encouraged; walk-ins will be taken on a first come-first serve basis. Camping fees are due upon arrival. Campers arriving and departing outside of the office hours must prepay their reservation in full *before* their arrival.
- 2. Check-In/Check-Out Times:** Campers may check in beginning at 2:00 p.m. and must check out by 11:00 a.m. unless other arrangements are made.
- 3. Vehicles:** For space and safety reasons only one vehicle is permitted per campsite. Additional vehicles must be parked in designated visitor parking areas.
- 4. Severe Weather:** Please be aware of all weather alerts. We appreciate your cooperation to relocate to a designated safe location if asked to by Beulah Personnel.
- 5. Pets:** All pets must be kept on a leash while on the grounds. Campers are responsible to maintain their pet's relief areas. Owners will be asked to remove their pets from the campground if the animals cause any disturbance. Pets are not permitted on the swimming beach.
- 6. Bicycles:** In the interest of safety, bikes ridden at night must be equipped with lights. Darkness is determined by the automatic lighting of the streetlights.
- 7. Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours are observed from 11:00pm to 7:00am. An adult must accompany all minors not at their campsite during those hours.
- 8. Shower house & Laundry Facilities:** Your cooperation in maintaining a clean facility will be greatly appreciated. Small children should be supervised while in the facility. Showers and laundry services are available during the season.
- 9. Campfire:** Fires are permitted with metal fire rings. Please be courteous to other campers near you by keeping smoke to a minimum. Cutting of live trees/branches for firewood is prohibited.
- 10. Sewer Hook-up:** To maintain our license with Erie County Health Department, a sewer hookup must use a donut seal. A dumping station is provided for campers. To see a complete list of campsites visit [bbeach.org](http://bbeach.org)
- 11. Picnic Tables:** Each site is provided with one picnic table; please do not remove it from the campsite.
- 12. Refuse Disposal:** Please use the trash containers supplied in the campground to help maintain sanitary conditions.
- 13. Tent Campers:** No digging of trenches around tents, please.
- 14. Age Restrictions:** No one under 18 is permitted to use the campground without adult supervision.
- 15. Swimming Area:** Lifeguards are provided only during recreation hours of programs. Swimming at any other time is at the swimmer's own risk. All swimsuits shall be conservative in style and of modest cut.
- 16. Wristbands:** upon arrival each guest will receive a wristband. This allows access to the campgrounds, beach, and pool area.

*If a problem should arise during your stay, please notify the office, located in the lodge. After office hours, dial the phone number posted on the lodge porch. Beulah Beach is a smoke-free, alcohol-free, illegal drug-free environment. Beulah Beach is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.*
